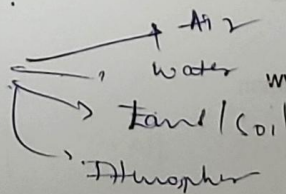
These holds the greatest lessons to us to re-route our approach and takeup the path of love towards nature.
